

REPORT ON THE CONSULTATIVE SESSION WITH DIRECTORS OF PPP NODES AND REPRESENTITIVES PPP UNIT - GOVT OF SINDH

Venue: Project Support Facility Office

Date:7th April 2026

A consultative session was conducted on April 7, 2026, under the leadership of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Public Private Partnership Support Facility (PSF). This session was attended by representatives from the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) Nodes across various departments in Sindh and representatives of PPP Unit. The proceedings began with the recitation of the Holy Quran. The CEO subsequently provided a succinct introduction to the PSF and outlined its role and mandate. He emphasized the critical importance of effectively and successfully implementing PPP projects in accordance with the Public Private Partnership Framework established by the Government of Sindh, as well as the significance of this session in advancing that objective.

The goal of the session was to deepen the understanding of departmental PPP Nodes concerning their institutional roles, the PPP project lifecycle, fiscal support instruments, and the coordination mechanisms necessary for the successful implementation of PPP projects aimed at sustainable development.

During the session, a comprehensive overview of the PPP Legal and Policy Framework of Sindh was presented, encompassing the relevant governing laws, policies, and regulatory structures. The discussion included a detailed examination of the PPP project lifecycle, highlighting all phases from project identification through to implementation. Moreover, the mandate and functions of the Public Sector Facility (PSF) were elucidated, particularly regarding its role in providing technical, financial, and advisory support. The presentation also covered key fiscal support instruments, including viability gap funding, annuity payments, capital contributions, and risk-sharing mechanisms. Additionally, the risk allocation framework and common challenges associated with PPP projects were addressed, alongside practical and sustainable solutions to these challenges.

The participants engaged actively throughout the discussion, sharing their perspectives and recognizing the significance of collaboration with the PSF for the enhancement of proposed project structuring and for the effective implementation and monitoring of these initiatives.

The session effectively provided a comprehensive overview of the PPP Framework in Sindh and highlighted the crucial role played by the PSF in the finalization of various ongoing PPP projects. It underscored the crucial importance of coordinated efforts among

all agencies, particularly the PPP Unit, PPP Nodes, the Project Implementation Units (PIUs), and other relevant stakeholders engaged in both proposed and current projects.
